Thank you for your letter dated July 29, 2020 providing supplemental information regarding Complaint 339157, submitted on behalf of the Lake Conroe Association. The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) reviewed the supplemental information provided and determined that your letter does not provide additional substantive information related to the complaint.

As discussed in the TCEQ's July 29, 2020 response to Complaint 339157, the TCEQ's authority over operation of Lake Conroe is limited to oversight of compliance with the terms and conditions of the Lake Conroe water right. After review, the TCEQ determined that the San Jacinto River Authority and the City of Houston are in compliance with the terms and conditions of Certificate of Adjudication 10-4963.
