

2018 Bond Program Monthly Update

Harris County Commissioners Court – December 2021



We have officially recognized Halls Bayou and Greens Bayou as two separate watersheds, increasing the official number of watersheds in Harris County from 22 to 23.

This decision builds on decades of work and investment in these watersheds to create and implement distinct flood risk reduction projects, including the development of the Halls Implementation Plan and the Greens Bayou Mid-Reach Program. The designation reinforces our commitment to each watershed and will hopefully help to clarify our work for the community.

This designation change will not impact our current project numbering system. Halls Bayou itself will remain P118-00-00 and projects will still begin with "P118" or "P518" to keep existing and future documents consistent and reduce confusion.

In addition, we closed out 2021 strong with 22 Community Engagement meetings for the year.





For CPI, anything above a 1 indicates a trend of being under budget and under 1 over budget. For SPI, anything above 1 indicates ahead of schedule and under 1 behind schedule.
