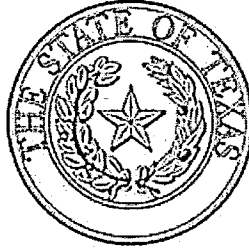

This cause, an appeal from the order signed on May 5, 2020, was heard on the appellate record.
